Dear Friends and Colleagues,

Greetings to you all for the year 2021 - the year of hope! The year gone by presented before us many hurdles and challenges and we are still coping with it. It hampered our schedules, way of thinking and living and the way we worked. We stumbled, panicked, felt handicapped and isolated. It stifled us and it stifled RSA too. But life still goes on.... We gathered ourselves and with help of family, friends, technologies and human will to overcome. Some way or the other we all found out ways to read, to teach, to converse, to meet, to express, to communicate and off course to get a work around about life in the given situation.

Though travel and meetings were restricted due to the pandemic, we were able to hold record number of Office Bearers and EC meetings during the period. I personally feel enthused with the support of the EC and RSA members and hope to get the same favour in future.

In the given situation of COVID-19, RSA has had its own share of problems but still we managed many moments of joy and accomplishments. First of all, Journal of RSA - Rajasthan Journal of Sociology which is our one of the mainstays and which was facing financial crunch due to discontinued grant from ICSSR, got a fillip through an assurance from IP Modi endowment fund for partial bearing of publication expenses and later on with restoration of Grants from ICSSR in March 2020 for the year 2019-20. We hope these patronages to continue in the years to come, both from IP Modi Endowment and ICSSR, and therefore RSA will not have to deplete its valuable but meagre membership fee proceeds to bring out the journal on its schedule.

We also had a remarkable shift in June 2020 as we migrated to Goggle Site page: **rajsa**: <https://sites.google.com/view/rajsa> from our old website which was slower in response and taking time to update. The new site hosts all information updated and is easy to operate and access. Now you have all association related information including back issues of Journal and images of RSA conferences and other activities at one place.



The journey of Rajasthan Journal of Sociology has been remarkable so far. It has maintained the standard, earned reputation and has been coming out unhindered in spite of many challenges. Professor N K Bhargava, his entire editorial team, editorial advisors and reviewers have been key to this success. One thing which had remained a matter of concern for a long time was the empanelment of the **journal in UGC-CARE** list of journal as somehow we had technically missed the bus in the beginning when this regime of empanelment started. RSA, Editors and all the members always felt that Journal deserves this recognition. We took up this challenge this time. Many colleagues, University and College departments recommended our journal in June 2020 as per prescribed protocol to UGC -CARE for its inclusion.

It was for the wishes, efforts and recommendations of esteemed colleagues and members of RSA like Prof. Sanjay Loda, MLSU, Udaipur; Prof. S L. Sharma, UOR, Jaipur; Dr. Shilaja Nagendra & Dr. Avni Sharma, SPC Govt. College, Ajmer; Dr. Sunita Sharma & Dr. Sudeshna Pareeja, Meera Girls College, Udiapur; Prof. Manish Thakur, IIM, Kolkata; Prof. B. N. Prasad, A N Sinha Institute, Patna; Prof. Manish Verma, BBAU, Lucknow & Mrs. Supriya Seth, Govt. Arts College, Kota; that RJS got a coveted entry in the UGC-CARE list of Journals in October 2020. This much awaited recognition puts on us increased responsibility of maintaining the quality and withstand the predatory onslaught on academic scholarship. And I am sure, RJS will successfully take up this challenge too!

In June 2020, we also successfully made initial submission and **title suggestion** of our Journal - Rajasthan Journal of Sociology(RJS) at Elsevier - SCOPUS and Web of Science Group - Clarivate Analytics for Social Science Citation Index for necessary evaluation by them. We are in receipt of confirmation of our submissions from both the entities and it will take about 8-12 months of usual time for the process to reach the final conclusion. We are hopeful that our Journal and our efforts will bring desired results.

You would be happy to know that the life membership of RSA has grown to 593. Since 2018, we have been regularly updating and e-publishing our membership directory. The latest one in the series: **Membership directory 2020** was e-published in January 2021 in the flipbook form which is convenient to operate. Many members have been requesting and inquiring for RSA Membership Certificates. Therefore, RSA made arrangement to provide e-certificate to all its members who wanted it. All the requests received through an online requisition form:

<https://forms.gle/KbMNQEiMAxS2ZR6Z7> were delivered and the facility will remain in force in future too.

All the members and RSA have been concerned about growth of sociology as a discipline in the state of Rajasthan. Its spread at secondary education level has been limited and due to some recent government orders, the teaching posts in some schools were eliminated. We also feel that at college and university level also, Sociology is not as much prevalent as it should be as compared to other social science disciplines. This concern led us to reach out to many authorities. A good number of members, on request of RSA, became part of this campaign and wrote letters the honourable CM and the education minister against curtailing of seats in sociology and voiced the need of spreading sociology widely at school level. Some members mobilized sociological fraternity at local level, made a representation with local MLA and MP to impress upon them to open Sociology in newly opened colleges in their area. We need to continue this effort. Slowly but surely, I am sure, it will bear results.

In the series of this campaign, we also reached out to newly established Govind Guru Tribal University, Banswara in October 2020 to start the teaching of sociology at post graduate level and we are very happy to share that with the efforts of Prof. Mohan Advani and Dr. Paresh Dwivedi (member - RSA EC), the Honorable VC of the University gave approval for the same in December 2020. We are thankful to the honorable VC for acceding to our request and hope that same kind efforts are taken up in other places where sociology as a department and subject is missing.

We know that RPSC - R.A.S. and in the new syllabus of the UPSC, which have been in force for the last few years, sociology has been almost marginalized. Because the syllabus covers fewer topics proportionally than other subjects...Certainly this is going to impact the subject and discourage students of sociology. Therefore, we have started evaluation of the syllabus and previous years question paper of RAS exams. Some member sociologists like Dr. Amithy Jasrotia, Mr. Manish Yadav and others have volunteered for this work and soon we plan to make our representation with RPSC in this regard.



We have had impressive number of proposals from RSA members to host RSA conference this time and RSA thanks all these members for their interest and patronage. As circumstances could not permit us to hold the conference physically, we had to adopt online mode and therefore RSA EC collectively decided to conduct this conference on its own with the help and active support of all RSA members. Therefore, I invite you all in this **XXVII International Annual Conference 2020 (Online) on Education and Society: Equity, Justice and Inclusion (Reassessing Emancipation and Subordination)** which is scheduled from 07th -10th February, 2021. We plan to have useful deliberations though panel discussions and various technical sessions. Please find all the details in this issue of the newsletter, register yourself and submit your abstract through the given link in time.

The e-newsletter of RSA apart from showcasing RSA annual activities, has always tried to be truly, representational of all sociological activities happening in the state. We always try to reach out to our members for relevant and important news related to their publications, academic achievements and important deliberations happening in their intuitions. Members have been very forthcoming in sharing this information with us. Only on that basis, we have tried to make this an effort to which the members of RSA await and look for. In the same vein, we do hope that this issue has been remarkable and exhaustive in its coverage and efforts. I am also very thankful to Dr. Parul Singh, a dedicated RSA life member and the editor of the current issue for easing me out from this responsibility in the wake of preparation of the annual conference at a very short notice and carrying out this work so diligently and beautifully. It will be matter of great satisfaction for me and RSA, if you appreciate this effort and continue to give us your valuable advice in improving it further.

Education and Society: Equity, Justice and Inclusion (Reassessing Emancipation and Subordination)

Concept Note

Social change and transformation are struggles for every society. Change from hosts of deprivations and exclusions to attain equity and justice require many measures in any society. But central to all such measures has been education, provided it is inclusive and promotes criticality, reflexivity and democratic values; and if it nurtures self-realization and promotes self-actualization of learners. Only then struggles for social change and transformations could gain significant and meaningful ground.

On the other hand, Society has its own needs: cultural and economic. It has an 'order' which is often skewed, stratified, dominated and hegemonized which tends to perpetuate and reproduce itself. Society, therefore, devises an education to socialize, skill, prepare and adapt its younger members to fulfil its needs and support the order even if it reproduces inequality and is non-inclusive, unjust and exploitative.

Thus, education in a society can be potent source of emancipation if it is envisioned and implemented

thoughtfully, else, it could be a tool of domestication and subordination for perpetuation of dominance and hegemony. It involves many actors and stakeholders such as learners, teachers, administrators, business/ industry leaders, policy makers and community at large. There are many inputs such as curricula, pedagogy, texts, knowledge and research, institutional set-ups, technology & infrastructure, teaching aids and tools. All of these work in unison, though in varying measures that what kind of education a society will have.

For a country like India and society like Rajasthan which face the mammoth challenges of various social problems; it becomes utmost important for all of us to assess the nature and features of education that happens to be and what kind of society we are striving for.
